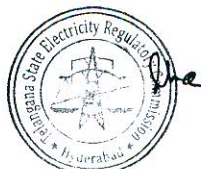

This petition came up for hearing on 02.05.2018 and 02.06.2018. There is no representation for the petitioner on 02.05.2018 and Sri. N. Phani, Advocate representing Sri. Challa Gunaranjan, Advocate for the petitioner appeared on 02.06.2018. Sri. Y. Rama Rao, standing counsel for the respondents along Sri. M.V.R. Prasad, Advocate appeared on 02.05.2018 and Sri. Y. Rama Rao, standing counsel for the respondents along with Ms. Pravalika, Advocate appeared on 02.06.2018. The petition having stood for consideration to this day, the Commission passed the following:

ORDER

M/s. Sarvaraya Sugars Limited has filed a petition under section 86 (1) (f) of the Electricity Act, 2003 seeking directions for payment of compensation bills along with surcharge on late payment power bills, reimbursement of short term open access



(STOA) charges and open access reconciliation bills in terms of the power purchase orders for the period 10.07.2016 to 25.05.2017.

2. The petitioner has sought the following prayer in the petition.

“ a) to direct the respondents to pay Rs. 2,81,68,383/- towards compensation on account of deviation by more than 30% of the contracted energy for the period from 10.07.2016 to 25.05.2017 in terms of the purchase order vide Lr. No. CE (Plg. Comml & Coordn / SE (Comml) / DE (STPP) / PO. No. 66 / 15 – 16 / D. No. 3396 dated 05.03.2016 and the monthly compensation bills, consolidated bill dated 16.06.2017 issued by the petitioner along with surcharge for late payment @ 1.25% per month .

b) to direct the respondents to pay Rs. 15,28,388/- towards surcharge @ 1.25% per month on delayed payment of monthly power bills, reimbursement of STOA charges and Open Access reconciliation bills as per the calculations statement annexed herewith.”

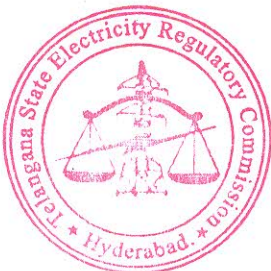
3. I have heard the counsel for the petitioner and standing counsel for the respondents and perused the material on record. During the course of hearing on 02.06.2018 the counsel for the petitioner has stated that the petitioner is willing to withdraw the petition and in terms of the said statement the counsel for the petitioner has filed a memo, which is extracted below.

“It is humbly submitted that as per the instructions of my client, a settlement has been arrived at with the DISCOMs. Therefore, we are withdrawing this O. P. Therefore, we request the permission of this Hon'ble Commission to withdraw O. P. No. 1 of 2018.”

4. Accordingly, the petitioner is permitted to withdraw the petition and the petition is dismissed as withdrawn, but in the circumstances without costs.
