First Amendment Regulation To

Regulation No: 2 of 2007 of APERC

[Appointment of Vidyuth Ombudsman and Terms & Conditions of service]

Introduction

Whereas the A.P. Electricity Regulatory Commission (hereinafter referred to as “the Commission”) notified the Andhra Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission (Appointment of Vidyuth Ombudsman and Terms & Conditions of service) Regulation No. 2 of 2007 in A.P. Extraordinary Gazette dated 3rd July 2007.

In exercise of the powers vested with it under sub-sections (6) and (7) of section: 42 of the Electricity Act-2003 and all powers enabling in that behalf, Andhra Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission makes the following Amendment Regulation to the said Regulation No. 2 of 2007 of APERC (Appointment of Vidyuth Ombudsman and Terms & Conditions of service), namely:

1. Short title, commencement and interpretation

- (i) This Regulation may be called the A.P.Electricity Regulatory Commission, First Amendment to Regulation 2 of 2007 (Appointment of Vidyuth Ombudsman and Terms & Conditions of service).
- (ii) This Regulation shall come into force on the date of its publication in the Andhra Pradesh Gazette.

2. Clause 3 (f) of the said Regulation No: 2 of 2007 [Appointment of Vidyuth Ombudsman and Terms & Conditions of service] shall be substituted by the following:

Clause 3 (f) Pay and Allowances of Ombudsman:

The Ombudsman shall be entitled for pay as per the pay scale of Rs67000-79000. In addition, he shall be entitled to DA, HRA and CCA in accordance with Central Government rules. Other benefits shall be as admissible to the employees of the Government of Andhra Pradesh

Where a retired person is appointed as Ombudsman, the gross pension, including the commuted value thereof, together with dearness relief shall be deducted from the monthly salary
